The training program will help CTSO leaders gain more clarity and understanding on the nonprofit management side of running the CTSO. While CTSOs are charitable education organizations, they operate in a unique ecosystem powering the future of our economy and communities. Learn the partner relationship between the national, state, and local organizations; get familiar with current issues and opportunities; and come up to speed on structure, organization and culture, and your strategic and policy formulating roles.
